

All Presentations:

- Need to be quickly accessible, with minimal downtime to bring up the presentation.
- Have a back-up copy available (saved and shared with me in Google Drive; thumb drive)

Time Constraints:

- Seniors: Presentations and Podcasts: no less than 8 minutes; no more than 15 minutes.
- Others:

General Requirements for oral presentations:

- Your initial presentation must last at least 8 minutes, but should not exceed XX minutes.
- You must develop an effective introduction for your topic (think “three-pronged thesis” in a verbal form).
- A visual medium of your choosing.
- A **summary** (at the end) that highlights the main points for students (You must end your presentation with a summary of your main points).
- ALL GROUP MEMBERS MUST PARTICIPATE IN THE PRESENTATION.
 - Students who are absent from the presentation will receive a 50% reduction in their individual grade. These points can be regained by completing an independent research project.

“PROFESSIONALISM:”

Group members are expected to maintain a “professional” demeanor and appearance during the presentation.

This means

- Having rehearsed their presentation in advance.
- Not reading, verbatim, everything on the screen or other visual medium (i.e., note cards, papers).
- Not using offensive language in the presentation (i.e., referring to mentally ill people as being “crazy”)
- Refraining from interacting with the audience in a conversational way (talking with a member of the audience)
- Acting immature during the presentation (giggling, and generally not taking the presentation serious.)

FINAL PRODUCT—For All:

- Title Page in APA format.
- An Abstract Page
- The “meat” of your project (i.e., sentence outline, written paper)
- References Page (the final page of the product)
- “Handouts” printout of slides, 3 per page (for primarily slide presentations only)
- Everything double-spaced, 1 inch margins, in APA specified font size

For Slide Presentations/Podcasts/Videos:

- Full annotated sentence outline showing citations (assembled with the above items), submitted to Turnitin by 8:00 AM. (Seniors: 8:00 AM on Monday, 6/6; Others: 8:00 AM on Wednesday, 6/8)

For Papers:

- Fully assembled paper (with everything shown above, except for slides) assembled and submitted to Turnitin 8:00 AM. (Seniors: 8:00 AM on Monday, 6/6; Others: 8:00 AM on Wednesday, 6/8)
